#### Geography

Maps must have a **key** to explain what symbols mean.

**Compass points** North, South, East and West.

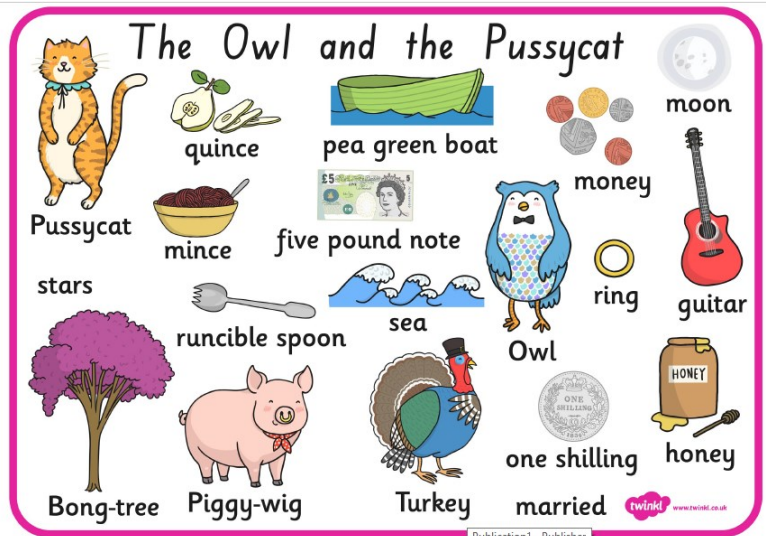
word	meaning
forest	A large area filled with many trees
hill	land that is higher than the surrounding land
mountain	land that is much higher than the land around it.
ocean	a body of salty water
river	freshwater stream of water that flows across land
sea	a small body of salt water
soil	the top layer of the earth
valley	low areas between hills and mountains
vegetation	plants

#### What is a poem?

- A poem is a piece of writing that **expresses feelings and ideas** using **imaginative language**.
- Rhyming words:** Words that have the same last sound e.g. cat/hat
- A **poem** is made up of words and some words **rhyme**.
- Rhythm:** A strong pattern of sounds and words
- Some **poems** have a fast **rhythm**, while others are slow.

#### How to memorise a poem:

- There are different ways to remember a poem. You might picture parts of the poem, or use the rhythm of the words.



#### Science

**Food chain** A chain usually starts with a green plant and shows the way food is eaten.

**Habitat** A place where an animal naturally lives.
