
## This week in Reception

# Week beginning 11/3/24

## Phonics:

In Phonics we will be continuing to revisit all the phase 3 digraphs and trigraphs – ai, oa ee, igh, ur, or, er, ar, ow, oi, ear, air. We will be reading words longer words – market, finger, towel, cornet, river, wooden. We will be reading words ending in -ing such as looking, marching, farming, cooking, waiting, morning, zooming, winking, singing, fighting, chatting. We will be reading compound words such as farmyard, rooftop, carpark, popcorn. We will be spelling river, finger, looking, waiting, singing, zooming, towel, fantastic, was, you, they, all.



# What we are learning:

In Literacy, we will be sharing the story of 'Super Daisy' and looking at action words. We will be making up our own versions of the story to retell and writing sentences.

In maths, we will be counting forwards and backwards to 20 and using counting on and counting back to solve problems of addition and subtraction. We will begin looking at half of a number by sharing a number in 2 equal groups.

#### At home

Collect 2, 4, 6, 8, or 10 objects and split them into 2 <u>equal</u> groups to find half of a number.

Write the following sentence applying digraphs and trigraphs: Hear the brown owls hoot in the night.

Make a list of all the qualities a real - life superhero shows.
