Science – Life cycles - Notice that animals including humans have offspring that grow into adults.

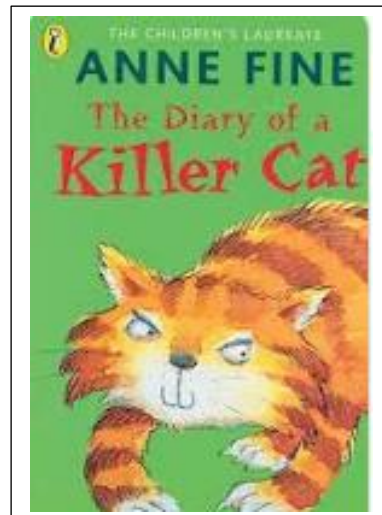
Geography – identify hot and cold places
