Science – micro habitats

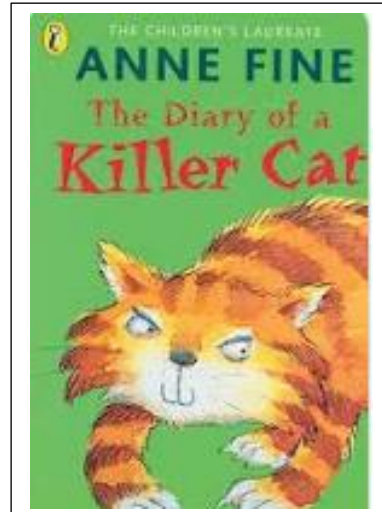
Geography –hot and cold places and how animals adapt.
